RESOLUTION NO. 1527.03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003/2004, COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2003 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2004; PROVIDING FOR A BUDGET BASIS; PROVIDING FOR EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach, Florida is a municipality located in Miami-Dade County, Florida; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the Town of Golden Beach, Florida's final budget for fiscal year 2003/2004 was held at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 16, 2003 at the Town of Golden Beach Town Hall, One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the amount available from taxation equals the total appropriations for expenditures and reserves;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Budget Adoption. The Town of Golden Beach's final budget for the fiscal year 2003/2004, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is approved and adopted and shall become effective at the beginning of the 2003/2004 fiscal year, and the City's funds may be expended commencing October 1, 2003 and ending September 30, 2004.

<u>Section 2.</u> Budget Basis. The proposed expenditures in the final budget are as shown in the budget and by reference made a part hereof.

<u>Section 3.</u> Expenditure of Funds. The Town Manager or her designee is authorized to expend, or contract for expenditures, such necessary funds for the operation of the town government in accordance with the budget adopted hereby.

<u>Section 4. Carryover of Funds.</u> Funds of the Town's 2002/2003 final budget not expended during the current fiscal year 2002/2003 may be used and expended during subsequent fiscal years.

<u>Section 5. Notice.</u> The Town Clerk is directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser; the Miami-Dade County Revenue Collector; and the Florida Department of Revenue.

Section 6. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 7. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 8.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
