A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA CREATING A 75TH ANNIVERSARY COMMITTEE TO ASSIST THE TOWN MANAGER IN PREPARING FOR THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH WITH SAID COMMITTEE'S EXISTENCE TO CEASE WITHOUT FURTHER COUNCIL ACTION THIRTY (30) DAYS FOLLOWING THE EVENT; PROVIDING FOR MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an ad hoc committee is created to assist the Town Manager by providing input and assistance in organizing the events surrounding the Town's 75th Anniversary.

<u>Section 2.</u> That one member of each of the following committees shall be designated by their respective committee to assist the Town Manager as described in Section 1 above: Beach Committee, Beautification Committee, Security Committee, Recreation Committee and the Pedestrian Committee. Additionally, the Town Manager may, in her sole discretion, include additional residents of the Town of Golden Beach to be on the committee.

Section 3. The Ad Hoc Committee's existence shall cease thirty (30) days following the final 75th Anniversary event.

<u>Section 4. Severability.</u> That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 5. Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
