RESOLUTION NO. 1538.03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO RETAIN THE SERVICES OF NATHAN CHARLES, PHD. TO ASSIST THE TOWN MANAGER IN PERSONNEL RELATED ISSUES ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town Manager is hereby authorized to retain the services of Nathan Charles, PhD. on an as needed basis for the purpose of assisting the Town Manager in personnel related issues with the rate of compensation to be \$125.00 per hour exclusive of travel time which is not compensable.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all related documents subject to the approval of both the Mayor and Town Attorney.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
