RESOLUTION NO. 1574.04

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA ASSIGNING EACH COUNCILMEMBER THE DUTY TO INQUIRE INTO THE OPERATION OF A PARTICULAR AREA OF GOVERNMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS IN ORDER THAT THE COUNCILMEMBER SHALL BECOME INFORMED AS TO THE OBJECTIVES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GOLDEN BEACH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 3.05 of the Town Charter the elected officials listed below are hereby assigned the duty to inquire into the operation of a particular area of governmental responsibility relating to the Town of Golden Beach in order to become informed as to the objectives of the Town Government. This assignment shall remain in effect for a period of six months unless amended by resolution or motion of the Town Council.

Section 2. That the various areas of Town Government are hereby assigned as follows:

Public Works & Beautification
Finance & Personnel
Building Department
Police & Public Safety
Administration & Legal

Councilmember Einstein
Councilmember Singer
Vice Mayor Paruas
Councilmember Iglesias
Mayor Addicott

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
