A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA SUPPORTING THE KERI BROOK HELKEN SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN ADMINISTRATION TO MAKE A CONTRIBUTION ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Keri Brooke Helken Scholarship Foundation supports education and those individuals qualified to receive funds from the Foundation to further their education; and

WHEREAS, the Town supports eleemosynary endeavors whenever possible; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that a contribution to this Foundation supports the philosophy of the Town and serves a public purpose;

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The foregoing Whereas Clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2. That the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach supports the efforts of the Keri Brooke Helken Scholarship Foundation and authorizes the Town Administration to contribute \$500.00 to this Foundation.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
