WHEREAS, pursuant to law and properly noticed, a municipal election was held on February 15, 2005, in the Town of Golden Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to accept the certification of the results of the election and special election and designate a Vice Mayor pursuant to the Town Charter;

 - b. That based upon the results, <u>Ben Einstein</u> is declared Town Councilmember for a four year term, commencing immediately.
 - C. That based upon the results, <u>Judy Lusskin</u> is declared Town

<u>Section 3.</u> That <u>Judy Lusskin</u> is hereby designated Vice Mayor for a one-year term commencing immediately, to be followed by <u>Ben Einstein</u>, Vice Mayor for the succeeding one-year term as decided by the Town Council.

<u>Section 4. Severability.</u> That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 5. Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
