WHEREAS, the Town Council has had the opportunity to determine, after review of the backup material and upon presentation by staff, the lowest responsible bidder,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to enter into an Agreement with Graph Plex in the amount of \$9,250.00 for the Town Welcome Signage based upon the criteria established by the Code of Ordinances subject to the approval of the Mayor, if required by Ordinance, and upon the review and approval of the Agreement by the Town Attorney.
- <u>Section 2. Severability.</u> That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
- Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- <u>Section 4. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
