RESOLUTION NO. 1697.05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH CLARKE ENVIRONMENTAL MOSQUITO MANAGEMENT, INC. FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL SERVICES FOR THE 2005 SEASON IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,969.00; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Town Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign an Agreement with Clarke Environmental Mosquito Management, Inc. for mosquito control services for the 2005 season in the amount of \$9,969.00, a copy of which is attached hereto. Said Agreement is subject to approval by the Mayor and Town Attorney.

Section 2. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.



SUBJECT: Mosquito Control Program for 2005

BACKGROUND/HISTORY:

Last year we requested the services of Clarke Mosquito Control who holds the contract with Miami-Dade. This company is on the Miami-Dade County vendor list. Mr. Wilson inspected our Town and provided an emergency spraying when it was determined the limited amount of spraying that the County was able to provide to the Town. Mr. Wilson provided immediate assistance and again assisted us in spraying the event area prior to the 75th Anniversary Event.

Mr. Wilson has provided a full quote for the entire mosquito season that is quickly approaching. He quote is very clear as to the services that he provides. One major enhancement is that Mr. Wilson treats the catch basins which he pointed out to me is a major breeding ground for the larvae.

2005 Mosquito Control Program

Part I. General Services-Included with the Program

A. Survey and map development

1. Each Service performed will have a corresponding map generated to ensure consistent applications.

B. Mosquito Hotline (1-800-443-2034)

1. Residents will be able to call for information about the Program, products used or future control schedules.

C. Public Relations

1. Brochures and pamphlets, media day events
2. Each mosquito annoyance complaint/site is checked by a Technician.

E. Program staff and quality control

1. Employees are licensed by the State of Florida

Part II. Surveillance and Monitoring

A. Clarke's laboratory technicians will set one (1) Light Trap, once a week, placed strategically within the Town limits. The light trap will be counted and identified to mosquito species from May 1st through October 31st (26 weeks). This data on species and number of mosquitoes is invaluable in developing a control strategy as well as satisfying State of Florida guidelines for the justification to use adulticides.

Per Trap Setting.....\$140.00
Total for 2005 Season.....\$3640.00

Part III. Laval Control

All Catch basins within the Town limits will be treated with Altosid XR (a Growth Inhibitor Larvicide) during the months of May and September. Treating catch basins reduces the amount of *Culex* mosquitoes, which are known Vectors of the Encephalitis diseases.

Catch Basin Treatment (each).....\$8.50
Total for 2005 Season.....\$840.00

Part IV. Adult Control

A. Eleven (11) Town Wide Ultra-Low-Volume (ULV) applications (rounds) via truck-mounted equipment, with Anvil 2+2 insecticide, will be performed on a scheduled basis or on call (weather and mosquito population permitting). The Town of Golden Beach will be mapped into a spray route (approx. 10 ULV miles per round). The Town of Golden Beach will be consulted prior to any decision being made on when or where Treatments will be performed.

Cost per Mile.....\$49.90
Cost per Round.....\$499.00
Total for 2005 Season.....\$5489.00

Mosquito Control Program total cost for 2005....\$9,969.00

Billing options are flexible, from lump sum to monthly billing spread out for the remaining year.
