RESOLUTION NO. 1724.05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; DETERMINING THE CURRENT YEAR ROLLED-BACK RATE; ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR THE FIRST AND SECOND PUBLIC BUDGET HEARINGS AS REQUIRED BY LAW; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO FILE SAID RESOLUTION WITH THE PROPERTY APPRAISER OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF FLORIDA STATUTES AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2005, the Honorable Joel Robins, Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County, Florida, served upon the Town of Golden Beach (the "Town"), a "Certification of Taxable Value" certifying to the Town its 2005 taxable value; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, require that within thirty-five (35) days of service of the Certification of Taxable Value upon a municipality, said municipality shall be required to furnish to the Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County the proposed millage rate, the current year rolled-back rate, and the date, time, and place at which a first public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage and the tentative budget; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to announce the dates of the first and second public hearings to the Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has reviewed the figures supplied by the Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County and conferred at a public meeting with the Town Attorney and that being otherwise fully advised in the premises.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed Millage Rate for the first public hearing shall not exceed 8.59 mills, which is \$8.59 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property within the Town of Golden Beach for the 2005/2006 fiscal year.

Section 2. That the current year rolled-back rate, computed pursuant to Section 200.065,

Florida Statutes, is 7.76 per \$1,000.00.

Section 3. That the date, time and place of the first and second public hearings are hereby set by the Town Council as follows:

Date: September 21, 2005
Time: 7:00 p.m.
Place: Town Hall

Section 5. That pursuant to the Florida Statutes, and the rules and regulations of the Florida Department of Revenue, the Town Clerk is hereby directed to attach the original Certification of Taxable Value to a certified copy of this resolution and serve the same upon the Honorable Joel Robbins, Property Appraiser of Miami-Dade County.


Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


