RESOLUTION NO. 1737.05

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE 2005/2006 FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2005 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2006; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2005, the Town of Golden Beach (the "Town") held a duly noticed public hearing on the adoption of the tentative millage rate; and

WHEREAS, the Town has considered an Operating Budget for the 2005/2006 fiscal year in accordance with the provisions of Section 200.065 of the Florida Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. That the tentative millage rate for the 2005/2006 fiscal year shall be and is hereby fixed at the rate of 8.59 mills which is \$8.59 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property value within the Town of Golden Beach.

Section 3. That the rolled-back rate for the Town of Golden Beach is 7.76 mills and that the tentative millage rate of 8.59 mills is 10.63% above the rolled-back rate.

Section 4. That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


The Motion to adopt the foregoing resolution was offered by Mayor Singer, seconded by Vice Mayor Lusskin, and on roll call the following vote ensued:


