

**GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA**

**RESOLUTION NO. 1741.05**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR ALL TOWN FUNDS FOR THE 2005/2006 FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2005 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2006; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager of the Town of Golden Beach (the "Town") has presented to the Town Council a proposed budget for the 2005/2006 fiscal year commencing October 1, 2005 and ending September 30, 2006 for approval by the Town Council; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 13, 2005, the Town Council held a duly noticed public hearing on the adoption of the proposed tentative budget; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 21, 2005, the Town Council held a duly noticed public hearing on the adoption of the final budget for the 2005/2006 fiscal year.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

**Section 2.** That the budget, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the 2005/2006 fiscal year commencing October 1, 2005 and ending September 30, 2006 is hereby adopted.

**Section 3.** That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

**Section 4.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


