RESOLUTION NO. 1763.06

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH BEACH ADVISORY COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2006, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach adopted Ordinance No. 501.2006, codifying the establishment of the Beach Advisory Committee (the "Committee");

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the Town to appoint Joe Iglesias, Helena Berrini, June Krogoll, Alene Fishbein, and Stephen Bermingham to serve as members of the Committee for one-year terms, allowing for re-appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Appointment and Term. That the Town Council hereby appoints Joe Iglesias, Helena Berrini, June Krogoll, Alene Fishbein, and Stephen Bermingham to serve as members of the Committee for an initial term through January 2007, allowing for re-appointment.

Section 3. Implementation. That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
