RESOLUTION NO. 1768.06

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY (POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE NO. 208, 2002 JEEP WRANGLER, V.I.D. 1J4FA49S62P752342); PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Manager of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida (the "Town") has recommended the sale of Police Department Vehicle No. 208, a 2002 Jeep Wrangler (V.I.D. 1J4FA49S62P752342) (the "Vehicle") as surplus Personal Property via public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle was purchased with Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies for use as a beach patrol vehicle; and

WHEREAS, due to its size and weight, the Vehicle has proven to be unsuited for Police patrol duties on the beach; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VIII "Personal Property" of Chapter 2 "Administration" of the Town Code, the Town Council finds that the disposal of the Vehicle via public auction is in the best interest of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Authorization. The disposal of Police Department Vehicle No. 208, a 2002 Jeep Wrangler (V.I.D. 1J4FA49S62P752342), as surplus Personal Property via public auction, as described and outlined in the Agenda Item Report attached and incorporated herein, is hereby

authorized and approved.

Section 4. Implementation. That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
