**RESOLUTION NO. 1777.06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF POLICE PATROL VEHICLE AND RELATED EMERGENCY VEHICLE EQUIPMENT FOR THE GOLDEN BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach, Florida (the "Town") wishes to acquire a 2006 Ford Explorer police patrol vehicle and related emergency vehicle equipment (the "Vehicle") as described and outlined in the attached Agenda Item Report; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the Town's purchasing procedures, the Vehicle shall be obtained from or through the State of Florida from advertised bid lists or procedures adopted by competitive bidding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that the purchase of this Vehicle is in the best interest of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.      Recitals Adopted.** That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

**Section 2.      Authorization of Purchase.** The expenditure of funds in an amount not more than \$29,365.00 for the purchase of a 2006 Ford Explorer police patrol vehicle and related emergency vehicle equipment, as described and outlined in the Agenda Item Report attached and incorporated herein, is hereby authorized and approved.

**Section 3.      Implementation.** That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take

any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
