## **RESOLUTION NO. 1809.06**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR ALL TOWN FUNDS FOR THE 2006/2007 FISCAL YEAR **ENDING** OCTOBER 1, 2006 AND COMMENCING FOR PROVIDING 30. 2007; SEPTEMBER PROVIDING IMPLEMENTATION; AND FOR ANEFFECTIVE DATE.

is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
