

I realize that Golden Beach is a very special place, and I am honored to have been entrusted to continue to steer the Town in the direction it needs to move. During my tenure with the Town we have seen the assessed value of our community explode from \$500 Million to \$1.95 Billion. Golden Beach continues to prove itself as a desirable place in which people from all over aspire to live. From our sensible millage rate, prudent Town Council, conscientious Town Hall staff and administration, to our expanded amenities and attentive service, Golden Beach is a community unlike any other.

We continue to improve. Upcoming initiatives include a proposed pump project on Center Island to address concerns in one of the areas of Town that is most susceptible to flooding.

The Town is also planning on introducing additional security measures, including surveillance cameras with thermal imaging options to bolster safety, as well as adding new license plate readers on Ocean Boulevard.

In the coming months we will continue with our feasibility study for a new Town Hall building and researching possible additional amenities for Residents within the project.

We are also addressing our waterways. This year we move forward with our eagerly anticipated canal dredging. The dredging process will allow for a five-foot drift at low tide and will ease concerns about navigability along the intracoastal.

We never stop looking for ways to make life in Golden Beach the best it can be. We're glad you've chosen Golden Beach as your home, and I am happy to continue to serve you.
