Letter FROM THE MAYOR

The Town of Golden Beach was incorporated under its present status, by a special act of the Legislature of the State of Florida in 1929. The act was approved and Golden Beach became a legalized community on May 23rd, 1929. Since that time, what was once mangrove swamps is now a community of stately homes renowned for its upscale image. Can you believe that was just 90 years ago?

Over the last couple of decades, the old infrastructure has given way to majestic new streetscapes and family-friendly open spaces. Environmental issues have necessitated replacing the stormwater system and undergrounding all of the utilities. The upkeep of our Beach Pavilion has garnered designation as a historical landmark by Miami-Dade County. I am very proud of all of these milestones.

We are very excited about what is happening in May. This year marks our 90th Anniversary and we have a number of events scheduled to mark this momentous occasion. The celebrations begin with a Street Fair on May 19th; we'll cut the anniversary cake at our Town Council Meeting on May 21st; host a movie night on May 22nd; and wrapping up with a wine social at the Beach Pavilion on May 24th. We are extremely proud of our Town, and the recent spurt in new construction indicates that others find the benefits of residing in Golden Beach as well.

With summer almost upon us, I'd like to remind our residents of the need for safety during the heat of the season. Remember to stay hydrated and wear light, loose-fitting clothing if you must spend any significant time outdoors. And if you are looking for some fun ways to enjoy the outdoors and at the same time get to know your neighbors, I encourage you to take advantage of all of the amenities the Town of Golden Beach offers.

Summer also brings on hurricane season. Adequate preparation is our greatest defense. We have included a detailed article in this issue on what you need to do to prepare in the event of a hurricane landfall in or near Golden Beach. As we get closer to the start of hurricane season, information will also be available from the Town's website and the Town's local television channel.

As the warmer weather approaches, I know that several of our residents are preparing to travel north. 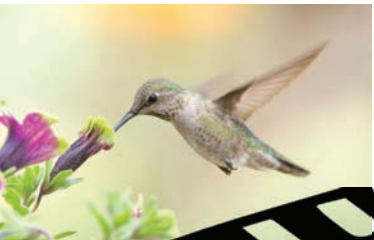

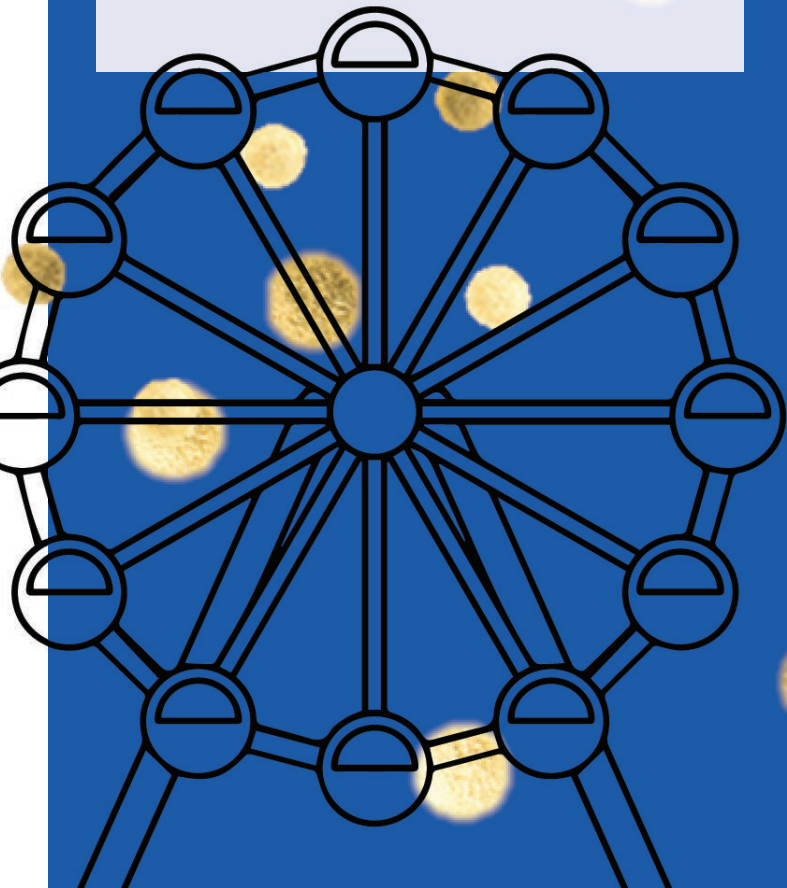
