## **RESOLUTION NO. 2606.19**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF (\$2,588,021.00) IN THE CAPITAL IMPORVEMENT TOWN'S **FUND** (\$562,697.00) IN THE BRIDGE FUND TO THE GENERAL AND APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF FUND: \$526,401.00 FROM THE DEBT SERVICE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN **EFFECTIVE** 

WHEREAS, the Town is currently carrying (\$2,588,021.00) in Capital Improvement Fund and (\$562,697.00) in the Bridge Fund since the completion of each project; and

WHEREAS, the Town has no intensions of ever collecting these receivables; and

WHEREAS, the Administration is recommending transfering these project costs to allow for a "cleaner statement" of the Town's Financial positioning; and

WHEREAS, the Administration is also recommending a transfer of \$526,401.00 from the Debt Service Fund to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Administration is recommending these funds be used for capital project costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>TRANSFER APPROVED.</u> That the Town hereby approves the transfer of \$3,150,718.00 in project costs to the General Fund.

Section 2. TRANSFER APPROVED. That the Town hereby approves the transfer of \$526,401.00 from the Debt Service Fund to the General Fund.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> That the Mayor and Town Manager are authorized to take any and all action which is necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
