RESOLUTION NO. 1051.97

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 1997 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1998 PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 200.065 (TRIM BILL); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 3, 1997 the Mayor and Town Manager presented to the Town Council a tentative millage for fiscal year commencing October 1, 1997 which was approved by the Town Council by Resolution No. 1049.97; and

WHEREAS, the Town has properly noticed the second public hearing scheduled for September 9, 1997 at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall located at One Golden Beach Drive, Golden Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the said second public hearing was held as noticed and the public and all interested parties having had an opportunity to address their comments to the Town Council and having complied with the "TRIM" requirements of the Florida Statutes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the final millage rate as presented by the Mayor and the Town Manager for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 1997 and ending September 30, 1998 be and is hereby fixed at the rate of 8.7377 mills which is \$8.7377 per one thousand dollars of assessed property value within the Town of Golden Beach.

Section 2. That the "rolled back rate" for the Town of Golden Beach is 8.4430 mills and that the final millage rate of 8.7377 mills is 3.490% above the "rolled back rate".
