RESOLUTION NO. 1053.97

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; ENDORSING AND SUPPORTING DESIGNATION OF A HISTORIC SITE AND CREATION OF A MUSEUM AND MEMORIAL AT THE RICHMOND NAVAL AIR STATION IN DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, South Florida has an interesting and important history in terms of the military service of its citizens and the role which its geographic location has played during the nation's history; and

WHEREAS, the public service and contributions to the nation which have been made by citizens of South Florida while serving in the armed forces are notable examples of honorable dedication to the United States of America, the ideals of freedom and democracy and the local communities as well; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Naval Air Station and other facilities in the South Florida area have been the sites at which such service of historical significance has taken place; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the public interest for the federal government to designate the Richmond Naval Air Station as a historic sit and for a museum and memorial to be placed at that location.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the above and foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. That the Town of Golden Beach, by and through the Mayor and the Town Council, hereby endorses and supports designation of a historic site and creation of a museum and memorial at the Richmond Naval Air Station in Dade County, Florida.
