A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE COLLECTION DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD RECYCLING MATERIALS BETWEEN BROWNING-FERRIS INDUSTRIES OF FLORIDA, INC. AND THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH TO BFI WASTE SYSTEMS OF NORTH AMERICA, INC.: AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE CONSENT TO THE TRANSFER: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Browning-Ferris Industries of Florida, Inc. has requested that the Town of Golden Beach give written consent to the transfer of the contract for recycling household materials to BFI Waste Systems of North America, Inc. ("BFI Waste"); and

WHEREAS, Sec.4.01(a)(2) of the Town Charter authorizes the Mayor to execute all contracts or other obligations on behalf of the Town as approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the request for transfer has been presented to the Town Council for consideration:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the written consent for transfer of the contract between Browning-Ferris Industries of Florida, Inc., a/k/a Industrial Waste Services, Inc. d/b/a Community Recycling, and the Town of Golden Beach, dated February 14, 1994, for collection and disposal of household recyclable materials, to BFI Waste Systems of North America, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Browning-Ferris Industries of North America, is hereby approved. The Assignment is attached to and made a part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Mayor is authorized and directed to execute the written consent to the transfer referenced in this Resolution.

<u>Section 3.</u> Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 4.</u> Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
