RESOLUTION NO. 1058.97

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE HUMANITARIAN FOOD DRIVE TO BE SPONSORED BY SOUTH FLORIDA FOOD RECOVERY AND THE METROPOLITAN DADE COUNTY FIREFIGHTERS AND FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, South Florida Food Recovery, in conjunction with the Metropolitan Dade County Firefighters and Fire Rescue Department, propose a food drive to be held during the week of November 3rd through November 10th, 1997 to provide food for the poor, needy and homeless in Dade County during the coming Holiday Season; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach recognizes the importance of this effort and the obligation of our entire community to provide assistance to those less fortunate.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach support and endorse the Humanitarian Food Drive and urge all residents and citizens of our Town to join South Florida Food Recovery and the Metropolitan Dade County Firefighters and Fire Rescue Departments in their efforts be bringing donated food to the nearest Fire Rescue Station during the week of November 3rd through November 10th, 1997.

Section 2. The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach urges all Dade County communities to join in this effort and this Resolution.


Section 3. That the Deputy Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this


