A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER AND HIS STAFF TO APPLY FOR A HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips abutting Department of Transportation rights-of-way areas must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council desire that the Town of Golden Beach beautify and improve various rights-of-way areas within the Town of Golden Beach by landscaping; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach wish to authorize the Town Manager and his staff to apply for a Highway Beautification Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Golden Beach hereby authorizes the Town Manager and his staff to apply <u>and sign agreements</u> for a Highway Beautification Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation.

Section 2. The Town Clerk of the Town of Golden Beach is hereby directed to send copies of this Resolution to the Department of Transportation and all other persons as

directed by the Mayor and Town Council.

<u>Section 3.</u> Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
