RESOLUTION NO. 1083.98

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; DESIGNATION COUNCILMEMBER SARI ADDICOTT AS VICE MAYOR FOR A ONE YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THE TOWN CHARTER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 6.06 of the Town Charter and based upon the results of the February 18, 1997 Town election, as certified by Resolution 1026.97, Councilmember Sari Addicott is hereby declared the Vice Mayor of the Town to serve in that capacity until the certification of the results of the February 16, 1999 Town election, at which time a successor to the position of Vice Mayor will be determined.

Section 2. That Vice Mayor Sara Chikovsky shall continue her term as Town Councilmember.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.

The Motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Fistel, seconded by Vice Mayor Addicott and on roll call the following vote ensued:
