RESOLUTION NO. 1094.98

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR GRANT FROM THE COPS (COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES) SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach currently utilizes federally grant-funded police positions to facilitate the development of several community-based programs, including Home Security Surveys, Crimewatch meetings, Bicycle Patrol and Community Outreach; and

WHEREAS, the COPS Small Community Grant Program is a noncompetitive grant program for law enforcement agencies serving communities with a population under 50,000 that will pay for a portion of the fourth-year salary and benefits of officers hired under other COPS grant programs.

WHEREAS, a fourth year on the COPS grant would partially alleviate the Town's financial burden for the aforementioned programs, which have brought about a positive community response; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach wishes to make application for the grant monies available through the U.S. Department of Justice COPS Office.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the above-stated preambles are true and correct and adopted by reference.

Section 2. That the Town of Golden Beach hereby authorizes the Town Manager to make application for a grant from the Small Community Grant Program in order to help pay for a portion of the fourth-year salary and benefits of existing COPS-funded officers, and to execute any necessary amendments to the grant application and contracts, and take other acts as may be necessary to bind the Town of Golden Beach and accomplish the intent of this resolution.

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.


Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
