A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; APPROVING A TURF AND LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT RENEWAL WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR STATE ROAD A1A (OCEAN BOULEVARD); AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT RENEWAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town and the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") entered into an agreement dated July 17, 1996, whereby the Town would maintain the landscaping on State Road A1A (Ocean Boulevard) within the municipal boundaries of the Town; and

WHEREAS, said contract provides for a renewal; and

WHEREAS, FDOT and the Town desire to extend the contract for one year, expiring October 10, 1999;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Renewal Agreement with FDOT and the Town of Golden Beach is for landscape maintenance to be done on State Road A1A by the Town for which the State of Florida will pay the Town, is hereby approved, substantially in the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit 1.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the appropriate Town officials are hereby authorized to execute this Renewal Agreement.

<u>Section 5.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
