RESOLUTION NO. 1124.98

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; APPOINTING A TOWN COUNCILMEMBER TO FILL THE VACANCY ON THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE TERM UNTIL THE NEXT TOWN ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred on the Town Council as of July 16, 1998, based upon a resignation by Vice Mayor Sari Addicott, accepted by the Town Council on August 18, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to appoint a Councilmember to fill the vacancy, pursuant to the Town Charter;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Betti Lidsky is hereby determined to be legally qualified to serve on the Town Council.

Section 2. That Betti Lidsky is hereby appointed Councilmember of the Town of Golden Beach to serve during the unexpired portion of the term that expires upon the swearing-in of a successor following the February 16, 1999 town election. Nothing in this appointment precludes the appointee from seeking a subsequent term by election. Betti Lidsky is hereby afforded all the rights and responsibilities of this office as provided by charter, ordinance and general law.

Section 3. That this appointment is hereby determined to be a timely appointment by the Town Council.

<u>Section 4.</u> Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 5. Conflict.</u> That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6. Effective Date.</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
