GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NO. 1125.98

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA; DESIGNATING COUNCILMEMBER SARA CHIKOVSKY AS VICE MAYOR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED VICE MAYOR FOLLOWING THE FEBRUARY 16, 1999, TOWN ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 6.06 of the Town Charter and based upon the resignation of Vice Mayor Sari Addicott, accepted by the Town Council on August 18, 1998, Councilmember Sara Chikovsky is hereby declared the Vice Mayor of the Town to serve in that capacity until the certification of the results of the February 16, 1999, Town election, at which time a successor to the position of Vice Mayor will be determined.

<u>Section 2.</u> Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 4.</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
