WHEREAS, a vacancy exists for Deputy Town Clerk; and

WHEREAS, Town Manager Carole Morris has interviewed several candidates for the position and recommends the appointment of Rosemary J. Wascura, a Certified Municipal Clerk, with certification from the Advanced Academy for Education (CMC/AAE), who desires to serve in this position; and

WHEREAS, the Town Charter, at Sec. 3.04(d), provides that the Town Council shall appoint a Deputy Town Clerk; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Rosemary J. Wascura is hereby appointed Deputy Town Clerk effective November 9, 1998. Ms. Wascura shall serve at the pleasure of the Town Council. Her employment benefits as Town Clerk shall be:

- A. Salary at the annual rate of \$36,500.00, payable periodically as other administrative
- B. Such other benefits, leave, accruals, insurance coverage, retirement plan and other items as provided for salaried administrative employees of the Town.

Section 2. That Town Manager Carole Morris shall continue to serve as Interim Town erk until further action by the Town Council to the contrary. CR98098

Section 3. Severability. That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
