CODE NEWS

Golf Carts and Similar Motorized Vehicles

Ordinance 583.18 of the Town's Code of Ordinances lays out specifics that Residents should keep in mind when considering purchasing a golf cart or similar motorized sporting/recreation vehicle.

Some key points to keep in mind:

- Golf carts are **PROHIBITED** on Ocean Boulevard (A1A)
- Recreational vehicles are also **PROHIBITED** on beaches, parks, bicycle paths, sidewalks and swales of Town.
- Recreational vehicles CANNOT be operated by anyone under the age of 16
- All recreational vehicles MUST:
 - o Be inspected by the Golden Beach Police Department annually
- o Have a completed Permit Application on file with the Town, with proof of insurance, and paid \$15.00 application fee.
- All recreational vehicles MUST be equipped with:
 - o Reliable Steering Apparatus
 - o Safe Tires
 - o Rear View Mirrors

o Efficient Brakes

- o Red Reflectorized Warning Devices(in both front and rear)
- o Headlights
- o Brake Lights
- o Turn Signals
- o Windshield

- All recreation vehicles are **REQUIRED** to have a valid, current Permit issued by the Golden Beach Police Department, and must have it affixed in a conspicuous location.
- Recreational vehicles MUST observe all traffic laws, including usage of safety belts.
- Recreational vehicles MUST NOT interfere or obstruct normal traffic flow.
- Recreational vehicles MUST NOT carry more passengers than those for which the vehicle was designed.
- Parents considering purchasing a recreational vehicle for their children should communicate the rules and regulations of operating such a vehicle prior to allowing use.
- The Golden Beach Police Department has been tasked with enforcing policies and procedures in regards to Recreational Vehicles in Town.

Noise

Be considerate of your neighbors, the Town Code of Ordinances prohibits noise that is audible from outside of homes between the hours of 12:00 Midnight and 8:00AM the following day (for public property areas, like the Beach Pavilion, noise is prohibited between the hours of 10:00PM to 8:00AM). *Please note: If the following day is Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday then the restricted hours shall be extended to 10:00AM.

Keep Things Clean: Illegal Disposal

It is unlawful to deposit garbage, plant wastes, garden trash, rubbish and other materials on any vacant lots, or Town property, streets, storm drains, canals, and beach areas, and to deposit, sweep or blow grass onto Town streets or pile trash over storm drains. If you see an individual dumping on a vacant lot, or any other illegal dumping, call the Police Department immediately.

It is also unlawful to randomly dispose of used motor oil, paint, batteries, gas tanks, and other combustible or potentially hazardous material. Public Works **WILL NOT** pick up this kind of waste. Miami-Dade County has a facility located at 140 NW 160th Street that will accept these items for disposal. This center is open daily from 7 am to 5:30 pm.

If at any time items cannot be picked up during regular garbage/trash runs, a Public Works employee may leave an orange-colored door hanger to notify you of any violations. Please follow the directives outlined on the hanger.









