AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TOWN'S CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REVISE CHAPTER 14, "ENVIRONMENT," BY AMENDING SECTION 14-86, "LAWN MOWERS AND POWER TOOLS", PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

I	WHEREAS, the Town Council periodically studies land development trends and		
2	issues and amends the Town's Land Development Regulations accordingly; and		
3	WHEREAS, the Town Council has studied the current Code provisions of the Town		
4	and found that certain modifications are necessary and desirable to further regulate the use		
5	of lawn mowers and power tools; and		
6	WHEREAS, a public meeting was held before the Local Planning Agency (LPA) of		
7	the Town to review the proposed modifications to the Town's Land Development		
8	Regulations; and		
9	WHEREAS, the Town Council held duly advertised public meetings to consider the		
0	proposed modifications to the Town's Land Development Regulations.		
1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GOLDEN		
12	BEACH, FLORIDA:		
13	Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That the preceding "Whereas" clauses are		
14	ratified and incorporated as a record of the legislative intent of this Ordinance.		
15	Section 2. <u>Code Amended.</u> That the Town of Golden Beach Code is hereby		
16	amended to modify Article III. "Noises", Division 1. "Generally" of Article II "Nuisances," of		
17	Chapter 14, "Environment" as follows:1

35	of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid,		
36	that the invalidity shall not affect the other sections, paragraphs, sentences, words or		
37	application of this Ordinance.		
38	Section 4. Codification. That it is the intention of the Town Council of Golden		
39	Beach, and it is therefore ordained, that the provisions of the Ordinance shall become and		
40	be made a part of the Town of Golden Beach Code of Ordinances, that sections of this		
41	Ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intentions, and that the		
42	word "Ordinance" shall be changed to "Section" or other appropriate word.		
43	Section 5. Repealer. That all Ordinances, parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or		
44	parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent		
45	of such conflict.		
46	Section 6. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and take		
47	effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
