A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE INTERIM TOWN CLERK'S CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF THE FEBRUARY 15, 2011 TOWN ELECTION FOR MAYOR AND TWO **TOWN** COUNCILMEMBERS, DESIGNATING THE VICE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to law and properly noticed, qualifying for a municipal election was held from December 27, 2009 to January 3, 2011 in the Town of Golden Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to accept the unopposed re-election of Glenn Singer for a fourth term as Mayor; and

WHEREAS, for the Office of Councilmember two seats were up for re-election and three candidates qualified to seek office: Kenneth Bernstein, Beth Geduld, and Amy Isackson-Rojas; and

WHEREAS, the ballot results were as follows:

#40 Kenneth Bernstein 135 votes (43.27%) #41 Beth Geduld 62 votes (19.87%) #42 Amy Isackson-Rojas 115 votes (36.86%)

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to accept the re-election of Kenneth Bernstein for second term and Amy Rojas for a second term as Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to designate a Vice Mayor pursuant to the Town Charter.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Certification of the qualifying results of the February 15th, 2011 town election is accepted as follows:

B. Town Council: Kenneth Bernstein

Section 2. A. That based upon the results, Glenn Singer is declared Mayor for a two-year term commencing immediately.

B. That based upon the results, <u>Kenneth Bernstein</u> is declared Town Councilmember for a four year term, commencing immediately.

C. That based upon the results, <u>Amy Isackson-Rojas</u> is declared Town Councilmember for a four year term, commencing immediately.

<u>Section 3.</u> That Councilmember Kenneth Bernstein is hereby designated Vice Mayor for one-year term commencing immediately, to be followed by Councilmember Amy Isackson-Rojas, Vice Mayor for the succeeding one-year term as decided by the Town Council.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> That the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences and phrases of this Resolution but they shall remain in effect, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 5. Conflict. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
