A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) DISTRICT 6 SECRETARY TO CONDUCT A TRAFFIC STUDY TO INSTALL A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE FOR VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC AT TERRACINA AVENUE AND OCEAN BOULEVARD; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO WORK WITH SUNNY ISLES BEACH AND FDOT TO FACILITATE THE TRAFFIC STUDY; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Golden Beach supports the FDOT District 6 Secretary ("Secretary") to conduct a traffic study for the purposes of installing a traffic control device for vehicular and pedestrian traffic at Terracina Avenue and Ocean Boulevard, and;

WHEREAS, installing a traffic light that allows vehicles exiting Terracina Avenue onto Ocean Boulevard with a North and South turning signalization is in the best interest of the traveling public, and:

WHEREAS, for the purposes of pedestrian safety this traffic control device (light) would create a safer environment for those pedestrians seeking to cross Ocean Boulevard, and;

WHEREAS, should that study find that it is appropriate to install such a light, the light must be synchronized with the other two adjacent lights located at 193 and 191 Street and Ocean Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that there is a need for a traffic control device for vehicular and pedestrian traffic at 196 Street and Ocean Boulevard for use by the Town's residents and our neighboring community of Sunny Isles Beach; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council supports and encourages the Secretary to conduct this

study for the purposes of determining whether or not the installation of a traffic control device is appropriate and in the best interest of vehicular and pedestrian public at this location; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the Town and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF GOLDEN BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. That each of the above-stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.

Section 2. Expressing Support. That the Town expresses support for the FDOT District 6 Secretary to conduct a traffic study to install a traffic control device for vehicular and pedestrian traffic at 196 Street and Ocean Boulevard.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Authorization.</u> The Town Manager is hereby authorized to take any and all actions in furtherance of this Resolution, including working with Sunny Isles Beach and FDOT to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution.

Section 4. <u>Transmittal.</u> The Town Clerk is directed to transmit this Resolution to the Sunny Isles Beach and FDOT District 6. .

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval of the Town Council.
